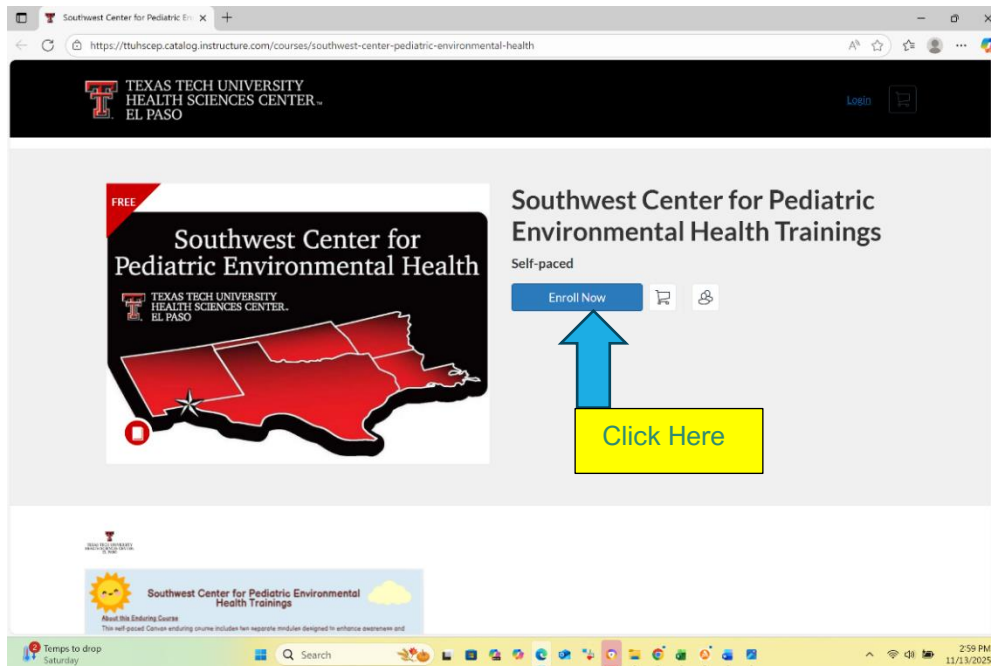

2. Log into account—top gray ribbon next to shopping cart.
3. Log in as guest (email can be used for username)
4. Click on your name (account) in top gray ribbon—It will pull up your dashboard.
 - a. Click on My Courses
5. Click on **Southwest Center for Pediatric Environmental Health Trainings**
6. Click on Healthy Homes Training, where you can access both the Healthy Housing Principles Training, and the Asthma Overview for the Environmental Assessors courses.

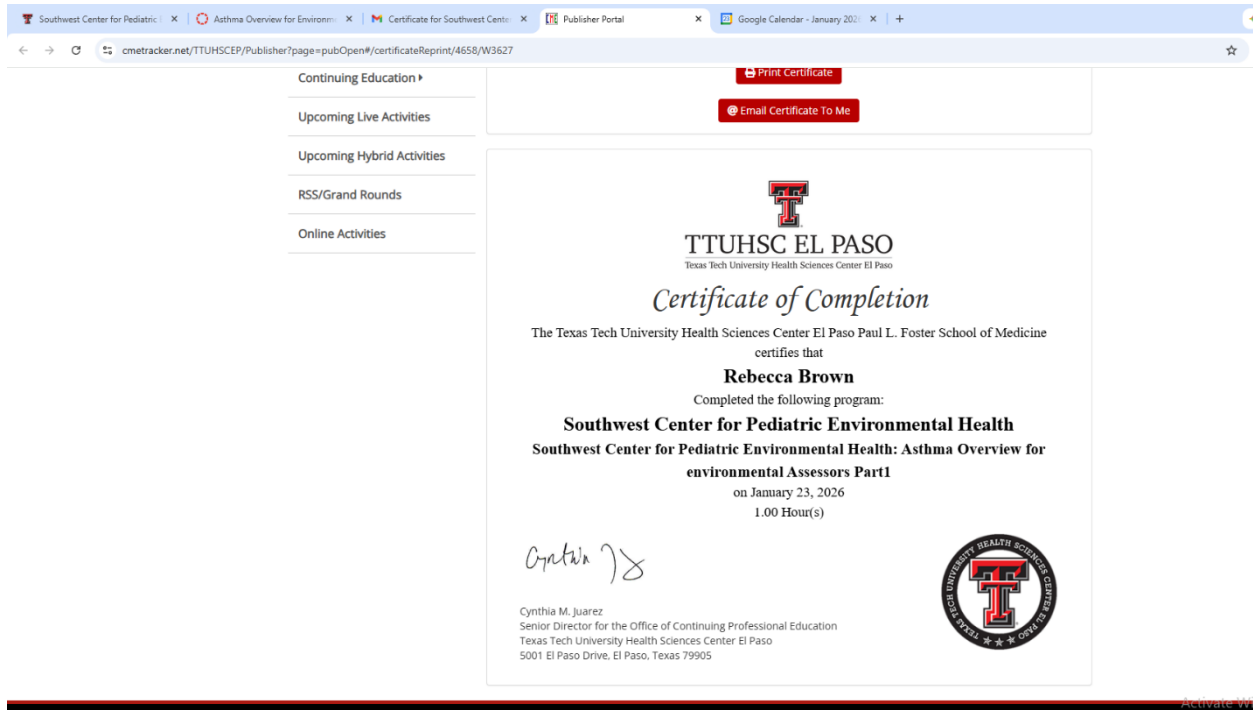
1. Upon completion of each module, use the QR code shown above the course video. The QR Code will take you to a separate system for accessing course completion certificate / hours of continuing education.
2. You will receive a separate certificate of 1 hour of credit for each completed module.
3. Each separate module has its own unique QR code, and activity code number; one will not work for all.
 - a. The Healthy Housing Principles course has eight separate modules; completion of all eight would yield eight separate certificates of 1 hour credit.
 - b. The Asthma Overview for Environmental Assessors has two separate modules; completion of both would yield two separate certificates of 1 hour credit.
4. The following documents (Attachments 1-3) will walk through registering **within the TTUHSC EP system** (Screenshots are included in the documents listed below).
 1. **Attachment 1: CME TRACKER ACTIVITY CHECK IN**—Goes over how to use the QR Codes shown above course videos to go to the Course Evaluation page. ****Please note that the Activity Code for each of the Healthy Homes training modules will pre-populate into the activity code box. ****
 2. **Attachment 2: HOW TO OBTAIN CPE DOCUMENTS**—How to obtain the certificate.

3. **Attachment 3: LOGGING IN TO CME TRACKER**—Goes over how to log in and how to create an account if a first-time user.
5. Please note: These courses / modules are accredited to award continuing education credits for physicians, nurses, dentists, pharmacists, and IPCE participants.

****Other healthcare disciplines can collect a certificate of attendance when they complete the evaluation that lists the number of hours. The learners are responsible for self-submitting documentation to their applicable licensing or certifying bodies. ****
